WHEREAS: People in all countries fear the results of a nuclear war; and

WHEREAS: People in all countries love their homeland and desire peace; and

WHEREAS: Many people in all countries desire that the leaders of nations would meet and work toward a peaceful co-existence; and

WHEREAS: The money spent for the build up of arms could be better used for the benefit of the poverty stricken people of the world; and

WHEREAS: All people, including children, have the right to ask their leaders to strive for peace; and

WHEREAS: If peace is to be, it is up to all people of the world to become involved:

NOW THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of May 26 through June 1, 1985 to be

in Minnesota, and I urge all people of the State of Minnesota to participate by writing letters to national leaders, leaders and friends in other countries, famous people and athletes in all countries, and any influential person to become involved in this effort for world peace.
