WHEREAS: The Needlework Guild of America, Inc. is an all-volunteer organization with a membership of 150,000 individuals; and

WHEREAS: The NGA is a national charity organization with 190 branches across the United States, including the Commonwealth of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: Since 1885, the Guild has been providing charitable agencies and institutions with a substantial part of the clothing they are called upon to give those in their care - the newborn, the handicapped, school children unable to attend classes for lack of clothing, migrant workers, the elderly and the chronically ill; and
