WHEREAS: Small business is recognized nationally during the month of May; and

WHEREAS: There are 43,000 small businesses in the Twin Cities metropolitan area, generating some \$20 billion in gross activity each year; and

WHEREAS: The Greater Minneapolis Chamber of Commerce is committed to supporting small businesses and helping them grow by offering productive activities throughout the year; and

WHEREAS: The Chamber's Small Business Trade Fair is one of the premiere events in the region to promote small business and its contribution to Minnesota's economy; and
