



SUBJECT: Urban Powers

1. At the annual meeting of Belle Prairie Township, held March 12, 1985 at the town hall, the voters were given the opportunity to vote by ballot, whether Belle Prairie Township should, or shouldnot adopt urban powers. The result of the vote was 37 yes votes to adopt urban powers and 2 no votes.
2. The Belle Prairie Town Board, took action, upon the majority vote of the people, to pass a resolution to adopt urban powers.
3. RESOLUTION NO. 1


