

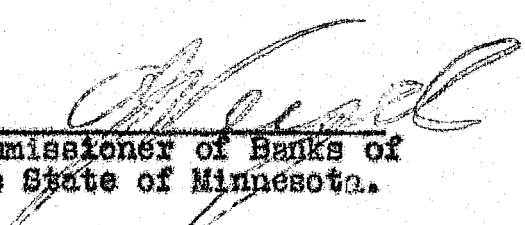

We, Mike Holm, Secretary of State, Samuel B. Nelson Justice of the Supreme Court, Ronald A. Stone, Justice of the Supreme Court, J. C.
