WHEREAS: Rabbi Max Shapiro has served as spiritual leader of Temple Israel Synagogue in Minneapolis, the state's largest Jewish congregation, for the past thirty years; and

WHEREAS: Rabbi Shapiro has brought to that congregation and to its neighbors his commitment to community service and involvement, his sense of social justice, and his joy in the brotherhood and sisterhood of all in the human family; and

WHEREAS: Rabbi Shapiro has been in the forefront of the fight against injustice that divides, fear and prejudice that demeans the human spirit, with a voice that brings together young and old, black, white, yellow and red, Jew and gentile; and

WHEREAS: Rabbi Shapiro shares with us all a wise, loving and caring spirit;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Saturday, June 1, 1985, to be
