ORDINANCE NO: 28.

AN ORDInANCE EXTENDING THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF SLEEPY EYE TO INCLUDE CERTAIN , PLATTED LANDS ABUTTING UPON THE CITY LIMITS

WHEREAS, a Petition was presented to the City Council of the City of Sleepy Eye requesting annexation of territory for platted land located in Home Township, and

Whereas, tho territory doscribood abuts upon the city limits and it is determined by the Council that ho property is presently urban in character;

The City of Sleepy Bye does therefor ordain as follows:
SECTION 1. The City Council hereby determines that the annexatimon will ho to the best internets of the city non of the territory
 limits and is urban in character, and that none of the territory
 LImEs of any other city.

SECITON 2, The corporate limits of the city are hereby oxtendod to include the platted land described as follows and the same is hereby annexed to and included within the city as effectually as if it had originally been a part thereof:

Lots $B-3-A$ and $B-3-B$ of $N W \frac{1}{4}$ of $N E \frac{1}{4}$, Section 32 , Township lion, Range 32 West, Brown County, MN., consisting of 1.15 acres, more or less.
