WHEREAS: The All-Star Game is the premier showcase for major league baseball; and

WHEREAS: The All-Star Game will be played in the Hubert H. Humphrey Metrodome in Minneapolis on July 16, 1985; and

WHEREAS: This will be the first time since 1965 that the All-Star Game has been played in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota's favorite team, the Minnesota Twins, will have representatives in the All-Star Game; and

WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota in general and the Twin Cities area in particular are honored, and are pleased to extend the warmest of welcomes to all visitors and participants, including the commissioner of baseball, Mr. Peter Ueberroth;
