WHEREAS: The Iron Miner of Minnesota has been responsible for recovering this vital natural resource from the earth; and


WHEREAS: The City of Calumet, Minnesota, and the Iron Range Resources and Rehabilitation Board annually recognizes those involved in the mining effort;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, July 21, 1985, to be


MINER'S DAY


