

## **Proclamation**

WHEREAS: Leukemia, a malignant disease of the blood-forming tissues, is the number one disease

killer of children and, not discriminating, strikes eight times as many adults as it

does children; and

WHEREAS: Leukemia or related disorders will be discovered in about 65,000 Americans this year

and 38,300 others will die from the disorders; and

WHEREAS:

Most of the life-saving modern approaches to all malignant diseases, such as combination chemotherapy drug treatment, specialized blood transfusions and all-out supportive care of the patient, were first pioneered through leukemia research; and

WHEREAS: Grants in excess of 740,000 are being provided by the Leukemia Society of America, Inc.

to researchers at the University of Minnesota and Mayo Clinic who are a part of a world-wide community of scholars seeking a cure to leukemia; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Chapter of the Leukemia Society of America, Inc. is striving to provide

patient aid and services to all leukemia victims in our state and public support is so

desperately needed;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim August 18, 1984, through September 17, 1985, to be

LEUKEMIA AWARENESS MONTH

in Minnesota.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-third day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eightyfive, and of the State the one hundred twenty-
