



## Proclamation

WHEREAS: The 1935 U.S. Congress passed legislation requiring state and federal governments and employers to cooperate in insuring unemployed workers; and

WHEREAS: For fifty years, the unemployment insurance system has been lessening the economic impact of joblessness on individuals and their communities; and

WHEREAS: Minnesotans have benefited from the stabilizing influence of unemployment insurance; and

WHEREAS: The unemployment insurance system will continue to ensure the economic well-being of Minnesota and the entire nation; and

WHEREAS: The fiftieth anniversary is an event of special import to all citizens;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Wednesday, August 14, 1985, to be

### UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE DAY

in Minnesota and do hereby commend state unemployment insurance offices and employers for their efforts in providing temporary compensation to jobless workers as they seek reentry into the labor force.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this fourteenth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-five, and of the State the one hundred twenty-seventh.
