WHEREAS: This proclamation and the Minnesota Annual Black Musical Awards Ceremony express the commitment of the State of Minnesota and the public to honoring these citizens, the Black musicians and educators of our great cities and state;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Thursday, September 26, 1985, to be
