WHEREAS: Through CWA bargaining, thousands of workers today enjoy decent wages and salaries, good pensions, paid insurance and vacations and protection from inflation; and

WHEREAS: The CWA has defended every American's right to a safe and healthy environment at work and at home, a decent minimum wage, legal equality, protection against unemployment, affordable health care, tax justice, social stability, world peace, opportunity and jobs; and
