WHEREAS: The field of Emergency Medicine is a medical specialty that has established itself as an invaluable part of the total health delivery system; and

WHEREAS: The field represents the cooperative efforts of emergency physicians, nurses, paramedics, emergency medical technicians, and first responders, all of whom have saved countless lives; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota's response system—from utilization of 911, to the first responders, to the arrival of the paramedics and emergency medical technicians, through the stabilization and transport to the hospital emergency department's physicians and nurses—represents a model for other states; and

WHEREAS: September 29 through October 5, 1985, is being observed nationally as Emergency Medical Services Week;
