



Proclamation

WHEREAS: The Minnesota State Arts Board was established twenty years ago to encourage excellence in and accessibility to the arts in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota State Arts Board has provided national leadership in the establishment of public/private partnerships in support of the arts; and

WHEREAS: The National Endowment for the Arts, our nation's federal arts agency, was also established twenty years ago; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota State Arts Board and the National Endowment for the Arts have worked with the arts organizations and artists of Minnesota over the past two decades to create an environment for the arts of such national prominence to recognize that Minnesota is the State of the Arts;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 23 through September 29, 1985, to be
