

## **Proclamation**

Each year 15,000 Americans suffer some form of spinal cord injury resulting in a total cost of four billion dollars per year for medical care, maintenance, lost income and WHEREAS:

supportive services; and

The average age of the victims of spinal cord injury is nineteen years; thus these people spend most of their life-times with all the long-term medical problems and WHEREAS:

suffering associated with paralysis, including: diminished heart and lung capacity, kidney failure, recurring bladder infections, osteoporosis, skin ulcerations, and

muscle atrophy: and

WHEREAS:

The Spinal Cord Society is a non-profit organization of the spinal-injured, their families and friends, and dedicated scientists and physicians who are all aiming at the ultimate goal of cure for the 500,000 spinal cord injured people in this country

through the means of improved treatment and research; and

WHEREAS: The Spinal Cord Society is linked by 120 chapters, a monthly newsletter, and thousands

of members throughout North America and twenty other countries; and

WHEREAS:

The Spinal Cord Society, in conjunction with the University of Minnesota, has established a Spinal Cord Center whose ultimate goal is the total reconstruction and reactivation to normal function of injured spinal cords, and the systematic reversal of

all disabilites associated therewith; and

WHEREAS: The Spinal Cord Society has sponsored some ten major research conferences over the last

two years at which prominent scientists and clinicians present papers, exchange

information, and keep the public informed; and

WHEREAS: The more than 35 million severe neural cases in the United States outnumber all other

disorders, including heart disease and cancer, and a cure for spinal cord injury would be a major breakthrough for all mental disorders;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim September 16 through 22, 1985, to be
