



## Proclamation

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Humanities Commission, an affiliate of the National Endowment for the Humanities, was part of a great experiment which grew out of Congressional legislation in 1965 establishing the National Endowment for the Humanities and in 1970 allowing states to form citizen committees to distribute funds in support of cultural programs produced by local institutions in each state; and

WHEREAS: During the past 13 years the Minnesota Humanities Commission has sponsored more than one thousand projects throughout Minnesota, disbursing more than four million dollars to support a broad range of programs, covering all disciplines of the humanities; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Humanities Commission has been consistently designated by the National Endowment for the Humanities as one of the nation's outstanding state humanities councils;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 29 through October 5, 1985, to be
