- WHEREAS: The primary endeavor of these conscientious single parents is to bring their children to healthy maturity with the full sense of being loved and accepted as persons, and with the same prospects for normal adulthood as children who mature with their two parents together; and
- WHEREAS: Through approximately 1,000 chapters throughout the United States, Canada and other countries, Parents Without Partners has helped countless adults and children benefit from professional and educational services which cooperate closely with chapters, thereby enabling them to help themselves to a greater understanding and ability to handle the many difficulties involved in their state of life; and
- WHEREAS: Parents Without Partners was founded in October, 1957, in the State of New York, and this year is celebrating its 28th Anniversary; and
