WHEREAS: On September 17, 1985, it will be one hundred and ninety-eight years since the drafting of the United States Constitution, which gives us the foundation for a free, prosperous, and independent life for every citizen of our country; and

WHEREAS: The people of the United States of America should be deeply grateful for, and fully understand the provisions of this most uniquely written document ever produced; and endeavor to work to maintain our rights and freedoms and perform our duties to our country; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the week of September 17 through September 23, 1985, to be

CONSTITUTION WEEK

in Minnesota and urge all our citizens to pay special attention during this week to our Federal Constitution and all the advantages of American Citizenship.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Minnesota to be affixed at the State Capitol this twenty-third day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and eighty-five, and of the State the one hundred twenty-seventh.
