WHEREAS: The Farmers Home Administration (FmHA), an agency of the United States Department of Agriculture, has provided financial assistance to farmers and rural communities for the past 50 years; and

WHEREAS: In recent years, the FmHA has loaned nearly 15 billion dollars annually to rural areas to be used for housing, farming, community facilities, business and industry; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota farmers and rural residents receive personal financial services through the FmHA, which has extensive experience in dealing with credit problems, capital needs of small communities, and farm loans; and

WHEREAS: It is appropriate to commemorate the 50 years of service to Minnesota with an appropriate observance;
