



Proclamation

WHEREAS: The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, the Minnesota Housing Finance Agency, the Metropolitan Council of the Twin Cities, the Association of Metropolitan Municipalities, along with realtors, home builders, manufactured housing producers, building codes and standards experts, planners, architects and local government officials are joining together to promote affordable housing in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: Providing affordable housing gives first-time home owners an opportunity to share in the good life in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: October 24, 1985, is the date of a Joint Conference on Affordable Housing, at the University of Minnesota in St. Paul;
