



Proclamation

WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota is blessed with a multitude of innovative linkages among universities, industries and agriculture, leading to the development of new and useful knowledge and to the transfer of technology for improving the quality of life; and

WHEREAS: In Minnesota beneficial bridges are being built between medical technology, biotechnology and computer science, the fruits of which will enhance the health and mental health of people within and beyond Minnesota's borders; and

WHEREAS: A conference of the nation's preeminent scholars and practitioners in knowledge transfer is convening this week in Minneapolis, honoring one of the world's most significant contributors to knowledge transfer, the late Howard R. Davis, whose intellectual and professional awakening were nurtured in Minnesota and reached fulfillment at the National Institutes of Mental Health; and

WHEREAS: This same conference will conclude its deliberations with the establishment of a scientific and professional society devoted to the cultivation of knowledge transfer as a learned discipline and field of endeavor;
