WHEREAS: In Minnesota, 8.6 percent of the judges are women, which is more than double the national average of four percent; and

WHEREAS: During the Perpich administration, 16 women were appointed to the judiciary -- the largest number of appointees in state history; and

WHEREAS: Our state's commitment to the representation of women in the judiciary and throughout state government is an important one and must continue; and

WHEREAS: The National Association of Women Judges is devoted to advancing the needs of women judges and to addressing both their professional and their personal concerns; and

WHEREAS: On behalf of the people of our great state, I welcome everyone attending the 1985 National Association of Women Judges Seventh Annual Conference;
