WHEREAS: Irene D. Kreidberg spent 43 years as an employee of the Sperry Corporation and upon retirement became the General Manager and opened the new U of M Alumni Club in the IDS Center, and retired for the second time in 1977; and

WHEREAS: She devotes her time as a volunteer for civic and charitable, non-profit organizations, primarily related to the arts and culture in the area; and

WHEREAS: She was the first woman president, the first woman national area 12 director, and the first national functional director of education for the administrative management society; and

WHEREAS: She was the first woman elected to the Board of Directors of the Greater Minneapolis Chamber of Commerce for more than 10 years; and

WHEREAS: She chaired or co-chaired the World's Largest Marching Band, Metrodome event for Scandinavia Today, Business Salutes the Arts, Big League Sports Salute the Arts, 100th Anniversary for Minneapolis Public Library, Guthrie Theatre, and numerous other tribute luncheons; and
