

Proclamation

WHEREAS: Traumatic injury is a major threat to American Indians and Alaskan Natives; and

WHEREAS: Accidents are the second leading cause of death among American Indians in Minnesota but only the fourth leading cause of death for all state residents; and

WHEREAS: The Indian Health Service in Minnesota and tribal staffs have initiated activities for preventing injury by promoting use of motor vehicle seat belts, child vehicular restraints, and other injury-prevention strategies;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim November to be
