WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota has been a leader in the community education movement since it was initiated in Minnesota at the 1969 Conference on the Lighted School; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Legislature consistently has supported the community education concept in each legislative session since the first legislation was passed in 1971; and

WHEREAS: Local school boards, citizen advisory councils, and local governments throughout Minnesota have supported the community education concept; and

WHEREAS: Community education provides for full use of school and community facilities to bring lifelong learning opportunities to people of all ages, from all walks of life, and the right to education to every citizen in the state; and

WHEREAS: Community education is an integral part of the total educational effort of a community; and

WHEREAS: November 19 has been declared National Community Education Day and incorporated as part of American Education Week; and

WHEREAS: The American Heart Association - Minnesota Affiliate has joined with the Minnesota Community Education Association to promote this special day using the theme "Building Healthy Communities";

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim November 19 to be
