- WHEREAS: Key Club International, a high school service organization sponsored by Kiwanis International, is observing the first week of November as Key Club Week; and
- WHEREAS: Key Club International in the state of Minnesota is comprised of more than 532 high school students in 19 schools across the state; and
- WHEREAS: The local members are part of an international organization of more than 112,000 students dedicated to serve with purpose their school and community, seeking to give primacy to the human and spiritual rather than the material values of life; and
- WHEREAS: They promote the adoption of higher standards in scholastics, sportsmanship, and social contacts and the development of a more concerned citizenship; and
