



Proclamation

WHEREAS: The health of mothers and children is of vital importance to the future of the State of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: 1985 is the 50th Anniversary of Title V of the Social Security Act (Maternal and Child Health/Handicapped Children's Program) that has provided leadership and funding to promote the health of mothers, children and families in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: An active partnership exists between public and private agencies and organizations working together toward the improvement of maternal and child health services throughout Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: National, state and local officials, public and private health care professionals, faculty and students of the University of Minnesota Program in Maternal and Child Health and family advocacy groups will join together on November 7, 1985, to reflect on the accomplishments of the past 50 years and to exchange ideas on improving maternal and child health services in this time of increasing demands and limited resources;
