490.126, SUBDIVISION 2.


WHEREAS, the Honorable John F. Thoreen,, Judge of District

of District Court since August 1, 1967; and


WHEREAS, the said Honorable John F. Thoreen has satisfied the

business on January 31, 1986.


NOW, THEREFORE, I, RUDY PERPICH, Governor of the State of
