WHEREAS: Ski for Light is an international cross-country skiing program for blind and visually impaired adults; and

WHEREAS: Ski for Light is holding its eleventh annual week-long program based in Duluth, Minnesota in February, 1986; and

WHEREAS: The Ski for Light International Week, from February 9 through 16, 1986, also will offer instruction in sled skiing to people with mobility limitations; and

WHEREAS: There will be one instructor per disabled skier, a policy designed to ensure that this event is as meaningful to every individual as possible; and

WHEREAS: Ski for Light has become very successful because people who love cross-country skiing, the outdoors and health through fitness have shared their skills and enthusiasm with others, who, with a little guidance, can develop similar skills and maximize their enjoyment;
