WHEREAS: Providing choice among public schools can also encourage professional educators who

wish to establish effective, innovative programs; and

WHEREAS: More than 30 school districts have decided to provide choices among different kinds of

programs; and

The concept of providing choice among public schools has been endorsed by a variety of WHEREAS:

groups, including the Minnesota Parent Teacher Association, Minnesota League of Women Voters, Directors of Community Action Programs, Minnesota Association of Secondary School Principals, Minnesota Elementary School Principals Association, Citizens League,

People for Better Schools and Minnesota Business Partnership; and

The Minnesota Legislature adopted a plan permitting high school juniors and seniors to attend WHEREAS:

post-secondary institutions; and

More than 1,600 students are participating in this program; and WHEREAS:

Many parents and students have written and spoken favorably about this new post-WHEREAS:

secondary enrollment option; and

WHEREAS: A number of school districts are responding creatively to the post-secondary enrollment

option by improving their own course offerings;
