WHEREAS: Multiple sclerosis is a major neurological disease of young adults with no known cause or cure that afflicts two million people worldwide and strikes 200 new people each week - young people between the ages of 18 and 34 who are starting families and careers; and

WHEREAS: Students Against Multiple Sclerosis is a new national collegiate movement that will increase the public's awareness of multiple sclerosis while establishing long-term fund raising support for the National Multiple Sclerosis Society; and

WHEREAS: Students Against Multiple Sclerosis embodies the spirit of volunteerism and charitable giving; and

WHEREAS: The students at the University of Minnesota in St. Paul and Minneapolis have dedicated themselves to being part of the generation that can eradicate multiple sclerosis through the involvement of their campus, community and fellow citizens in educational and fund raising events throughout February;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim February to be

FURTHER, I call upon the people of Minnesota to join with me in supporting our students, who are becoming involved in a major national cause, the movement to wipe out multiple sclerosis.
