WHEREAS: A health fair offers health education in several forms, as well as screening for non-symptomatic diseases such as high blood pressure, glaucoma, and vision problems; and

WHEREAS: A health fair is an intensive, area-wide promotion campaign based on a week-long series of local health fairs held throughout a major metropolitan area, which includes an intensive follow-up program; and

WHEREAS: Education is the underlying and dominant focus of the three main aspects of the health fair — health screening tests, counseling, and follow-up; and

WHEREAS: The TV 11 Health Fair will aid you in learning about your health needs and ways in which you can help yourself to better health by your own efforts and better use of the available resources; and

WHEREAS: WUSA-TV, Med Centers Health Plan and the United Ways in the Twin Cities Area are co-sponsoring a Community Health Fair Week the second week of April;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the second week of April to be

in Minnesota.

FURTHER, I encourage the citizens of this state to help themselves to better health through their own efforts and better knowledge of the resources available in their communities.
