PROVISIONS OF MINNESOTA STATUTES, CHAPTER 490.






NOW, THEREFORE, I, RUDY PERPICH, Governor of the State of Minnesota, acting in accordance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes Chapter 490, do hereby order and direct the retirement of the Honorable Charles F. Gegen, Judge of Dakota County Court, First Judicial District, State of Minnesota, said retirement to be made effective on April 2, 1986. He shall become entitled thereafter to such retirement compensation provided under the provisions of Minnesota Statutes Chapter 490.
