ORDINANCE NO. 25

AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF EITZEN, HOUSTON COUNTY,  
MINNESOTA, TERRITORY ABUTTING ON SAID CITY PURSUANT TO THE  
PROVISIONS OF SECTION 414.033, MINNESOTA GENERAL STATUTES,  
AS AMENDED

The City Council of the City of Eitzen, Houston County, Minnesota,  
ordains as follows:

WHEREAS, George Pottratz and Lucille Pottratz, husband and wife, and  
Thomas Pottratz, a single person, being the sole owners of record of the real  
estate hereinafter described, duly petitioned the City Council of the City  
of Eitzen to have said real estate annexed to and included within said City,  
and

WHEREAS, Said real estate abuts on said City, is not included in any  
other municipality, is unplatted and does not exceed 200 acres in area, and

WHEREAS, The annexation of said real estate hereinafter described to  
said City will be in the best interest of said City, of said real estate, and  
of the territory affected thereby, said real estate being of an urban character,

NOW, THEREFORE, Pursuant to the provisions of Section 414.033, Minnesota  
General Statutes, as amended, due notice of Petition for Annexation in the within  
matter having been served and there being no objection in the matter, it is hereby  
declared that the hereinafter described real estate is hereby annexed to, included  
within and made a part of the City of Eitzen, Houston County, Minnesota, said real  
estate being situate in said County and is described as follows, to-wit:

All that part of the East Half of the Southeast Quarter of  
the Northeast Quarter of Section 32, Township 101 North, of  
Range 5 West of the Fifth Principal Meridian lying North  
of the North right-of-way line of Houston County State Aid  
Highway No. 2.

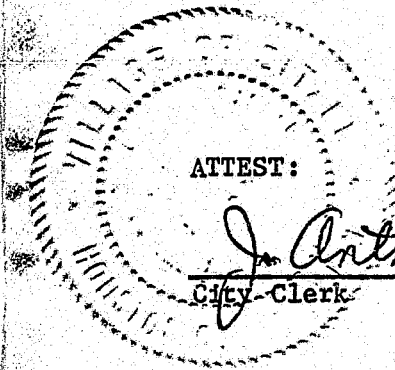
This ordinance shall become effective upon its due passage and enactment
