WHEREAS: 1986 marks the 850th birthday of Rabbi Moshe ben Maimon, one of the towering figures in the history of the Jewish people; and

WHEREAS: Rabbi Moshe ben Maimon was one of the greatest scholars in Jewish history; and

WHEREAS: He is recognized as one of the greatest physicians of the Middle Ages; and

WHEREAS: Israel, Spain, Morocco, Egypt, and other countries, as well as the entire world Jewish community, are celebrating this year as "The Year of Maimonides"; and

WHEREAS: A number of countries have issued commemorative stamps; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota celebration will be held on March 23, 1986;
