WHEREAS: A sound retirement plan is a vital instrument of personnel management in attracting and retaining a competent work force; and

WHEREAS: The federal government was a pace-setter in establishing a good retirement plan for its employees in 1920; and

WHEREAS: The National Association of Retired Federal Employees was chartered on February 19, 1921, to preserve and protect the benefits of federal retirees and has done so for the past 65 years;
