490.


WHEREAS, the Honorable Neil A. Riley, Judge of District Court, Fourth

January 4, 1965; and


WHEREAS, the said Honorable Neil A. Riley has satisfied the necessary

to 490.132 for such retirement at the close of business of June 30, 1986;


NOW, THEREFORE, I, RUDY PERPICH, Governor of the State of Minnesota,
acting in accordance with the provisions of Minnesota Statutes Chapter
490, do hereby order and direct the retirement of the Honorable Neil A.
Riley, Judge of District Court, Fourth Judicial District, State of
Minnesota, said retirement to be made effective on June 30, 1986. He
shall become entitled thereafter to such retirement compensation pro-
vided under the provisions of Minnesota Statutes 490. I hereby direct
that this Order be filed in the Office of the Secretary of State of the
State of Minnesota.
