WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota is actively committed to fostering partnerships with state and local governments and with the private sector to insure that housing opportunities are equal for all Minnesotans; and

The State of Minnesota is implementing the New Horizons Housing Opportunity Program, a statewide effort to assist government and business entities in the development and WHEREAS:

implementation of fair housing strategies, particularly with voluntary compliance of

existing housing laws; and

WHEREAS:

The New Horizons Housing Opportunity Program extends the range of equal opportunity activities beyond the area of law enforcement by promoting institutional change designed to secure voluntary compliance with the spirit of the law and its policy of

fair housing; and

WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota encourages localities to voluntarily undertake affirmative

measures to promote fair housing by providing local discretion and flexibility in the

development of fair housing strategies;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim April to be
