WHEREAS: Minnesota has long been dedicated to improving the quality of life for all of its disabled citizens; and

WHEREAS: As evidence, Minnesota serves as a model for encouraging barrier-free architecture in public and private buildings; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota is a national leader in providing transportation and vocational, educational and other support services for people with disabilities; and

WHEREAS: Courage Center is a state pioneer in providing programs that promote independence and self-sufficiency for children and adults with physical disabilities and speech, hearing and vision impairments; and

WHEREAS: Courage Center presents the National Courage Award each year to a person who has had a profound impact on attitudes toward and services provided for people with physical disabilities; and

WHEREAS: Itzhak Perlman has shown his concern about issues affecting people with physical disabilities in a multitude of ways; and

WHEREAS: In honor of his efforts, Perlman will receive the National Courage Award on May 21, 1986, in Minneapolis;
