WHEREAS: The United States' Jaycees have designated fundraising for MDA as a priority project, and the Minnesota Jaycees have endorsed this priority; and

WHEREAS: Recent breakthroughs in research of neuromuscular disease have raised realistic hope for significant future progress in the fight against neuromuscular disease in the foreseeable future;
