## ORDINANCE NO. 136

## ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR EVEN-YEAR CITY ELECTIONS

THE CITY COUNCIL OF IVANHOE ORDAINS:

Section 1. Date of Election. The regular City election shall be held biennially on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November in every even-numbered year, beginning with the 1986 election.

Section 2. Shortening of Terms of Council Members and Mayor. The terms of the Councilpersons whose current terms will expire on the first business day of January, 1988 are shortened so that they expire on the first business day of January, 1987, and those offices shall be filled at the 1986 election. The terms of the Councilpersons whose current terms will expire on the first business day of January, 1990 are shortened so that they expire on the first business day of January, 1989 and those offices shall be filled at the 1988 election. The term of the Mayor whose current term will expire on the first business day of January, 1988 is shortened so it expires on the first business day of January, 1987 and that office shall be filled at the 1986 election.

Section 3. Terms and Transition. Each Councilperson elected in conformance with Section 2 of this Ordinance shall be elected for four year terms commencing with the election held in 1986. The Mayor elected in conformance with Section 2 of this Ordinance shall shall be elected for two year terms at each election commencing with the election held in the year 1986.
