

## **Proclamation**

Alzheimer's disease is a progressive, irreversible neurological disorder that affects WHEREAS:

an estimated 2.5 million American adults; and

Alzheimer's disease is the fourth leading cause of death in adults and causes WHEREAS:

approximately 150,000 deaths annually; and

Alzheimer's disease affects approximately 60,000 Minnesotans; and WHEREAS:

WHEREAS: While most victims are over 65, people in their 40s and 50s and even younger can have

the disease; and

The symptoms include a gradual memory loss, decline in ability to perform routine WHEREAS:

tasks, impairment of judgement, disorientation, personality change, difficulty in learning and loss of language skills and in most cases the disease will eventually

render the victims totally incapable of caring for themselves; and

There is no single clinical test to identify Alzheimer's disease and confirmation of WHEREAS:

the disease requires examination of brain tissue, which is usually performed at

autopsy; and

Each person with suspected Alzheimer's disease should have a thorough neurological and WHEREAS:

physical evaluation; and

Most Alzheimer's disease victims are cared for at home, but many reside in nursing WHEREAS:

homes: and

The high cost of long-term care for Alzheimer's disease victims both at home and in nursing homes is estimated at more than \$34 billion annually and expected to increase WHEREAS:

to \$78 billion by 1990; and

The fact that the cause is not known and there is no cure makes further research WHEREAS:

mandatory for our society; and

To help ease the physical, emotional, mental and financial burdens of families and patients, a benefit variety show is being held Sunday, May 4, 1986; and WHEREAS:
