



Proclamation

WHEREAS: Sport Aid is nine days of sport for Africa, involving hundreds of athletes and millions of fans and culminating in a single worldwide event, "The Race Against Time;" and

WHEREAS: The Sport Aid week will be launched May 17 when an African runner lights an Olympic torch in the fire of a relief camp in Sudan and begins a run that will take him through 10 European capitals on his way to the steps of the United Nations in New York; and

WHEREAS: When the runner ignites the torch at the United Nations, five and ten kilometer races will begin in 80 cities around the world with all funds raised from contributions and sponsorships going to emergency aid and long-term relief and rehabilitation for Africa; and

WHEREAS: On May 25, 1986, at 10 a.m. "The Race Against Time" will begin at Lake of the Isles in Minneapolis, Minnesota;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Sunday, May 25, 1986, to be
