WHEREAS: Sister Anne Joachim Moore was born and educated in our great state earning degrees from Derham Hall High School, St. Mary's Hospital School of Nursing, the College of St. Catherine, the St. Paul College of Law and the University of Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: Sister Anne Joachim Moore established St. Mary's Junior College in 1964, developing the first two-year associate degree program for registered nursing in Minnesota and the United States; and
