



Proclamation

WHEREAS: The unification of the Minnesota trial courts has been discussed and considered for years past; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Legislature has passed enabling legislation to allow judicial districts to unify trial courts; and

WHEREAS: The Governor of Minnesota has supported court unification by messages and by appointing a commission to study and recommend court unification procedures; and

WHEREAS: The Fourth Judicial District, by a majority of all trial judges, has voted to merge all courts into one district court;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Thursday, June 19, 1986, to be
