WHEREAS: Carpooling, vanpooling, and bus riding improves the environment and the quality of life for employers, employees, and visitors in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: The current automobile occupancy rate of 1.28 people per vehicle could be increased by ridesharing to decrease traffic congestion, pollution and to open needed parking spots for visitors and shoppers without using state funds for new highways and parking ramps; and

WHEREAS: The special carpool, vanpool bus lane along highway I-394 called the Sane Lane is the first in the nation to be used during construction and its success is dependent on people changing from driving alone to ridesharing; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota Rideshare provides valuable consultation and matching services that assist employers and employees form carpools and vanpools;
