WHEREAS:	The state of Minnesota has more than 700,000 Norwegian descendants; and
WHEREAS:	Minnesota has the largest Norwegian population of any state or province in North America; and
WHEREAS:	Minnesota has the largest concentration of Norwegians in the world outside of Norway; and
WHEREAS:	Sons of Norway is the largest Norwegian fraternal organization in the world outside of Norway and has its headquarters in Minnesota; and
WHEREAS:	The young Minnesotans will bring both goodwill from Minnesota to Norway and also their tour will bring back to Minnesota deeper friendships and understanding between our two countries;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Rudy Perpich, Governor of the State of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the Anoka High School Band to be Minnesota's official Ambassador during its tour of Norway in 1986.
