WHEREAS: Jewish Vocational Service, St. Paul, Minnesota, has served the state of Minnesota in the areas of educational and vocational counseling, job placement, scholarship and loan assistance and manpower administration in meeting the career needs of its citizens since 1946 regardless of age, sex, race and creed; and

WHEREAS: Jewish Vocational Service has provided invaluable services in administering the Job Training and Partnership Act and Comprehensive Employment and Training Act programs to aid economically disadvantaged persons in St. Paul since 1974; and

WHEREAS: Jewish Vocational Service has been responsible for the St. Paul United Way's Career Opportunities Preparation for Employment program to provide counseling and testing services for low income, minority youth since 1969;
