AMENDED ORDINANCE 4.14

An ordinance annexing land into the City of Fosston.

Section 1. RECITALS.

A. WHEREAS, the City of Fossion owns the following described real property abutting said City:

---The Fosston Industrial Park plat and the North 238.0 feet of the East 238.0 feet of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SE 1/4 of NW 1/4), Section Four (4), Township One Hundred Forty-seven (147) North, Range Forty (40) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, Polk County, Minnesota.---

- B. WHEREAS, no part of said property is included in another boundary adjustment proceeding pending before the Minnesota Municipal Board, and no other municipality borders said property; and
- C. WHEREAS, members of the Fosston City Council have determined that annexation of the above described real property is and will be in the best interests of the City of Fosston, Minnesota, and of the territory affected; and
- D. WHEREAS, the City previously annexed property pursuant to an erroneous legal description.
- Section 2. THEREFORE, upon motion duly made, seconded and carried,

IT IS RESOLVED, that the aforedescribed real property be, and is hereby, annexed to and incorporated within the City of Fosston, Minnesota.

IT IS FURTHER RESOLVED that the prior annexation ordinance relating to the following described parcel be repealed:

---That part of the Southeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (SE 1/4 of NW 1/4) of Section Four (4), Township One Hundred Forty-seven (147) North of Range Forty (40) West of the Fifth Principal Meridian, described as follows, to-wit: Commencing at a point of the East line of said SE 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Sec. 4 which is 589 feet North of the center of the said Sec. 4, thence West and parallel with the South line of said Sec. 4 a distance of 320 feet, thence North and parallel with the East line of said Sec. 4, a distance of 13.7 feet, thence West and parallel with the South

line of said Sec. 4 a distance of 526 feet, thence North and parallel with the East line of said Sec. 4 a distance 724.6 feet more or less to the North line of the SE 1/4 of NW 1/4 of said Sec. 4, thence East on the North line of said SE 1/4 of NW 1/4 a distance of 846 feet more or less to the Northeast corner of the Sk 1/4 of NW 1/4, thence Southerly to the point of beginning, Polk County, Minnesota.—

Section 3. This ordinance shall be final and shall take effect and be in full force from and after the date on which it is passed, published, recorded and approved by the Minnesota Municipal Board.


